Specialized Equipment, Furniture and Hospital Beds

Equipment, furniture, and beds don't last forever. In order to provide the best care for our residents, these items periodically need to be replaced. Large items such as the ones listed below as well as smaller items like **wheelchairs** and **patio furniture** are all important in order to make Normanna a safe and comfortable **home**.

Specialized Hospital Beds & Mattresses

\$2500 each

Normanna Home's beds are 15 years old and at this point cost more to repair and maintain than to replace. Our residents deserve new beds and mattresses with the most up to date comfort and safety features.



Therapeutic Bathtub and Motorized Lift

\$6000 each set

Therapeutic bath-tubs and motorized lifts will assist residents from a seated position into a tub of warm water. The lift provides stability and security for the resident during the entire bathing process, including transport back to the comfort of their own room.

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Dining Room Furniture

\$1600 - \$2700 each set

The new specialized dining room furniture will be designed to look and feel like "normal" home furnishings, but well capable of withstanding the more intense stresses and strains of supporting less mobile residents with adjustable height settings.

Dania and Normanna Bus, Program Enhancements

In partnership with Dania Home, the bus is used for outings to hear music and watch sports, sightseeing tours and bowling tournaments. Best of all, we are in a position to respond to the needs of those in our care – we can leave at the appointed time, accommodate changes in plans, and stop when and where we like. Therapeutic Lifestyle Recreation and Music Therapy

Normanna has adopted the Eden Alternative as a guiding philosophy in our daily approach to resident care. The Eden philosophy is based on 10 principles that provide guidance on how we can help our residents continue living meaningful lives when they are unable to live independently. **Music Therapy, Therapeutic Gardening, Pet Visits, Hands-On culinary food experiences** are just a few of the activities that require ongoing funding.



Restorative Care & Physiotherapy Program Enhancements

Restorative Care is a philosophy that emphasizes maximizing the independence of residents by supporting them to do as much as possible for themselves. The current in-house physiotherapy program needs to be expanded to include a fixed area with permanent equipment set up a full time 'mobile' physiotherapist servicing both Dania & Normanna Home.
